

COLUMBUS TACO FEST RETURNS TO DOWNTOWN COLUMBUS BIGGER AND BETTER

COLUMBUS, OH. Thursday, April 4, 2019 — Columbus' newest foodie festival is back this spring and it will feature the finest local taco trucks and restaurants. The Columbus Taco Fest is the perfect getaway for tacos, tequila, and Mexican beer afficionados, while enjoying live entertainment with beautiful city views.

"In 2018, the first Columbus Taco Fest was launched in downtown Columbus inspired by the idea that a culturally rich event with beautiful city views, live entertainment, and culinary attractions can transform our community. The 2nd annual Columbus Taco Fest will take place on Saturday, May 18th, 2019, at Genoa Park in Columbus, OH. and is coming back bigger and better! The 2019 edition will feature more food vendors and drink stations, separating alcoholic from non-alcoholic beverages. Additionally, line control elements will be added, and vendor's menus will be limited to allow for quick and efficient service to make lines less stressful.

There will be live music all day, featuring local DJs and a mix of Latin and American local bands. A tequila garden will be located at the top of the amphitheater's stairs and will feature a private tequila tasting at 2pm, 4pm, and 6pm. Limited tickets will be available for sale.

Profits from the festival will benefit VETMotorsports, an outstanding award winning non-profit veteran support organization that uses active participation in and around organized motorsports as an innovative and highly effective form of non-clinical outreach. Additionally, the festival is partnering up with Dan Rosu, advocate of the movement "Love on Every Billboard" in Columbus, to help him share his mission of reminding the planet of who they are, and to spread love throughout the city.
